<b>Highway/Utilities (A)</b> <b>Cost: \$395,900.00</b>	Mobilization. Demolition and removal of the existing asphalt, sidewalk, curb and gutter and precast parking bumpers. Earthwork cut to waste from site to subgrade elevation. It is our understanding that the intent of this project is to reconstruct the roadway matching the existing elevations as close as possible. All material generated will be used as backfill throughout the project to the greatest extent possible, and the remaining excess cut material will be exported from the site. Concrete work consisting of 2.0 standard curb and gutter, sidewalk, ADA ramps, drive pad, concrete retaining wall including metal handrail. Roadway and parking lot construction consisting of subgrade preparation, aggregate base course 8 in

thickness, prime coat and SP- IV HMA 3 in thickness installed in one lift. Our proposal includes the striping and replacing ( 9) each parking bumpers.  
Crack fill and single application seal coat of existing parking lot behind Timbers Mall.  
Adjustment of (3) each drop inlets, (4) each manhole collars and (2) each water valves.  
Metal stairs from new parking lot the adjacent building.  
Traffic control devices during construction.
